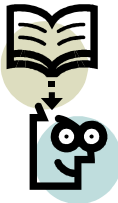




**I have heard some new laws on bringing liquid and portable luggage on international flights. I am a frequent flyer, so I care much about this case. Please tell me some details of the new laws ?**



*According to the written direction on the liquids prohibited in portable luggage on flights issued by Southern Airports Authority on 24/10/2007.*

*From 1/12/2007, such liquids as wine, perfume, pure water, cosmetic, ... are not brought in portable luggage as before. Each passenger is allowed to bring maximum 1,000 ml of liquid in their portable luggage, however they have to divide into each 100ml.*

*Milk and food for newborn babies are only brought in when passengers have accompanied newborn baby. The liquid bag should be transparent ( according to the standard of International Civil Aviation Organization – ICAO) to be able to see through the inside container. Medicine (liquid) must attach prescription including name, address of doctor and name, address of patient matching such information on boarding pass.*

*In necessary cases, these liquid bags may be opened for check or screened by X-ray at the Security check-point.*
